**RECOMMENDATION FOR FUTURE CONSIDERATION REGARDING  
CHANGES TO NATIONAL BYLAWS**

1. I propose that any changes that are made to the Marine Corps League National Bylaws following the Marine Corps League National Convention should be taken by the Department of North Carolina Judge Advocate where they will incorporate the changes into the standing Department Bylaws relating to change.

**RATIONALE:**

Currently, any change in the Marine Corps League National Bylaws must be individually incorporated into the Department of North Carolina Bylaws by singular requests. This method is inefficient. If the issue is important enough to rate a change to the Marine Corps League National Bylaws, I submit it is important enough for immediate adjustment into the Department of North Carolina Bylaws. The Judge Advocate would be able to brief the body on changes to the Bylaws that were made as a brief. Then the Bylaw Committee would be able to present change recommendations that were presented by the body that did not relate to National Bylaw.
