\*Harpers Ferry: About forty minutes from Martinsburg. The parking lot is remote from the site with bus transportation to and from the town. It is a lot of walking on a hillside but there are many restaurants, museums, and other attractions. https://www.nps.gov/hafe/index.htm

\*Antietam: Closest to Martinsburg at Thirty minutes. I have only done the December bus/ car tour at night where the volunteers light a luminary for each casualty clustered in the areas where the skirmishes took place.
