The impetus for this has been identified and I will work to turn this deterioration around.

No activities have taken place for the last quarter due to the COVID-19 lockout.

Detachments deserving special recognition in your District and reasons why:

All detachments are now meeting face to face, with PFC Bruce Larson giving other members remote access through ZOOM. All detachments are almost at 100% of their normal activities.

The Charlotte Detachment has recently approved the first Bylaws that approved the self-administering set of Administrative Procedures. Each consistently-formatted AP chapter will document the details of the job for every elected and appointed office and every committee. Eventually, this will enable any member to assume any position and have completely documented instructions to follow unique to the Charlotte Detachment. These chapters are evolutionary and will change as the situations dictate, all without the entire detachment having to vote on every change.
