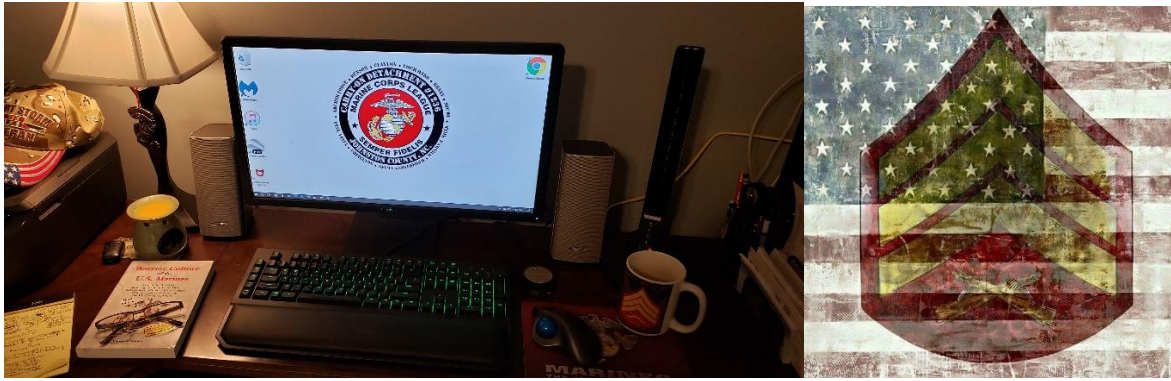


FROM THE COMMANDANT'S DESK
