- A motion to use our tent only at this year's Mountain Heritage Festival was approved.
- Marge Gray brought up her willingness to help the Detachment with the purchase, at bulk-discount, of needed new Marine Corps grave flags.

Report of Officers: We need to update our flags used on the float with finials too. We need a Certificate of Appreciation for John Wishon for his help with the trailer. Consideration should be made of removing \$2,000.00 from our Savings account and adding it to our Detachment Scholarship Fund (for later meeting discussion). Adjutant reported progress in organizing a Marine Corps cake cutting with a simple dinner at Olde Beau in November.

New Business: Marge Gray, our County Veteran Service Officer, discussed a presentation she will do to the local VFW Auxiliary regarding 'what to do' if a veteran has sudden medical problems or even death. Information to help a spouse react and move forward. At the VFW on 29 July at about 7:00 p.m., all are invited. The Commandant mentioned his having been contacted by a State representative about our interest in starting a MCL Detachment Auxiliary group in a separate matter.
